


- Check out holding library, location, and call N°. of the book using KULINE

- Look into the shelf signed as "RA"







How to use electricallypowered bookshelves

- 1. Push the yellow (bottom) button to turn on the machine
- 2. Push the green (top) button to move shelves and open path
- 3. Push the red (middle) button to stop shelves moving
- 4. Push the green and the yellow button after use






